The core laboratory performs approximately 10,000,000 tests per year primarily serving the 5 Clarian Health hospitals in the Indianapolis area and a rapidly expanding out-reach program. The successful applicant will lead the continued growth and expansion of the laboratory. Applicants must be certified by the American Board of Pathology in clinical pathology.
